There will be a Sausage sizzle for \$ 2.50 and a raffle on sale now from the Undercover Café (Canteen).

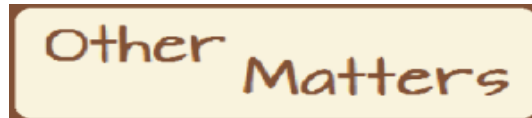
