[Amalgamation]



On 23rd June 2017, the P&C held a Special Meeting to put forward the proposal for the Amalgamation of the Westminster Schools and to proceed with further investigations and discussions with this process.

There have been several debates and rumours about the amalgamation of Westminster Primary and Westminster Junior Primary Schools over the years but the recent “push” for amalgamation has made its way to our School Boards/Councils and the P&C for further discussion and consideration.

There has been **NO** decision to amalgamate our schools on the existing site, but rather to investigate and discuss the amalgamation process. A consultation committee comprising parents, citizens and staff from both schools would be established to assist in the development of a consultation plan.

The proposal has been made for the Schools (WPS & WJPS) to amalgamate and the Westminster Education Support Centre to remain as is.

The amalgamation proposal of WPS and WJPS can be seen as an opportunity to promote unity and cohesion within our School Community and allow our children to **continue** to receive a high standard of education.

As information becomes available on the amalgamation process, the P&C will provide feedback and partake in any discussions as required.
