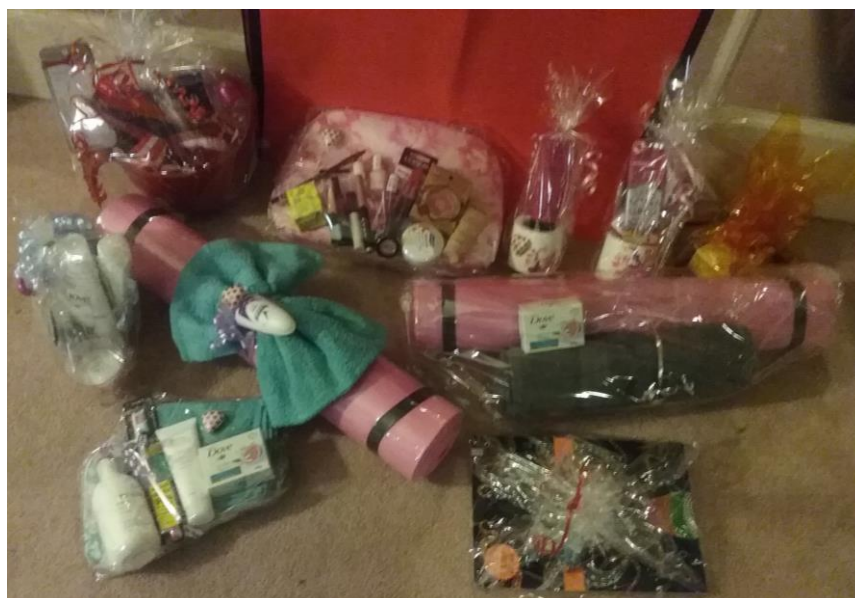
What's in May?
